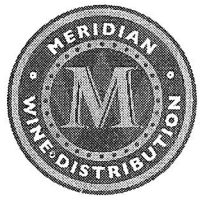

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Abstract *There is a growing concern that the use of mobile devices in the workplace is leading to a decline in productivity and an increase in errors. This study examines the impact of mobile device use on productivity and error rates in a manufacturing setting. The results show that productivity is significantly lower when workers use mobile devices compared to when they do not. Error rates are also higher when workers use mobile devices. The study suggests that the use of mobile devices in the workplace should be carefully monitored and controlled to ensure that productivity and error rates are maintained at acceptable levels.*

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
